The NSCN (I-M) is in the process of establishing a permanent office for it, and is planning to hold its first meeting in the foreseeable future. The first organizational meeting of the NSCN (I-M) was held in Jokeitung, China on March 4, 2014. After the start of peace talks between the Government of India and the NSCN (I-M), the NSCN (I-M) too signed a memorandum of understanding with the Government of India. The NSCN (I-M) accepted the Indian government's invitation to the 8th round of peace talks in New Delhi on April 14, 2015. The memorandum of understanding was signed by T. N. Pramod, the Chairman of the All Party Hurriyat Group and Atul Kansal, Secretary of the All Party Hurriyat Group on behalf of the NSCN (I-M). The NSCN (I-M) said that it was ready to participate in talks held to resolve the Naga issue in New Delhi. According to a confidential report released by the United States Department of State, the NSCN (I-M) is being represented by group chief Akungba-Anklet Taga, and its military leader T. Prakash Singh, who are headquartered in Thailand. The NSCN (I-M) was originally formed by Dr. Joseph Kony, the leader of the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA). On June 2, 2015, the NSCN (I-M) and the Government of India signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote lasting peace in the Northeast.
